EXPLANATION of the IMPLANT CARD:

The Patient Implant Card is intended for US patients who receive the TRILEAP™ Implants. The US FDA (Food & Drug Administration) recommends providing a Patient Implant Card to patients who are implanted with a medical device. The Card provides MRI safety status of the TRILEAP™ Lower Extremity Anatomic Plating System and URL/contact information where full MRI Safety information can be found.

It is recommended that patients carry the Card at all times to identify themselves as individuals who have the TRILEAP™ Implants. This card is useful for situations in which patients may need MRI scanning or must go through a metal detection device.
